

SoftOne GO: Use case (API)

Fetching Analyze Report Data via API (for Power BI)



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1. Summary

1.1 Introduktion till att det aktiva schemat i SoftOne GO

You're used to running Analyze Reports manually in SoftOne GO, but now you're building a Power BI report and want to fetch the data programmatically instead of exporting it manually.

Good news: there's an API for that!

This use case shows how to use two endpoints together to get the data you need – directly from the system.

2. How it works (3-step process)

2.1 Step 1: Authenticate

Endpoint: GET /token/login

This gives you:

- A token used for authentication purposes.

You use this to retrieve the **token** in further requests.

2.2 Step 2: Find your report and fields

Endpoint: GET /matrixreport/types

This gives you:

- A list of all available Analyze Reports in your customer instance
- Metadata about each report (fields/columns, filters, etc.)

You use this to find the **report ID**, and see what filters and columns are available.

2.3 Step 3: Get the actual report data

Endpoint: POST /matrixreport/output

Once you know the report ID and what data you're after, you call this endpoint with your selection criteria.

It returns the **report content as JSON** – perfect for Power BI or any system that can parse structured data.

3. Things to Know

- The API currently supports Analyze Reports from **Time**, **Schema**, and **Payroll** modules.
 - Reports from modules like *Economy* or *Finance* are not available yet.
- The result is **not** a PDF or Excel – it's **raw JSON**, which is easier to work with for automated analysis.
- What you see in the UI is (mostly) what you'll get via the API – same filters, same data structure.

Unlike in SoftOne GO, where Analyze Reports can run **asynchronously**, API calls are subject to **timeout limits**.

Here's how to make sure your integration doesn't fail due to long-running report generation:

Timeout limit: 240 seconds

- If the report can't be generated within this time, the request will **time out** and you'll get an error.

Best practice to avoid timeouts:

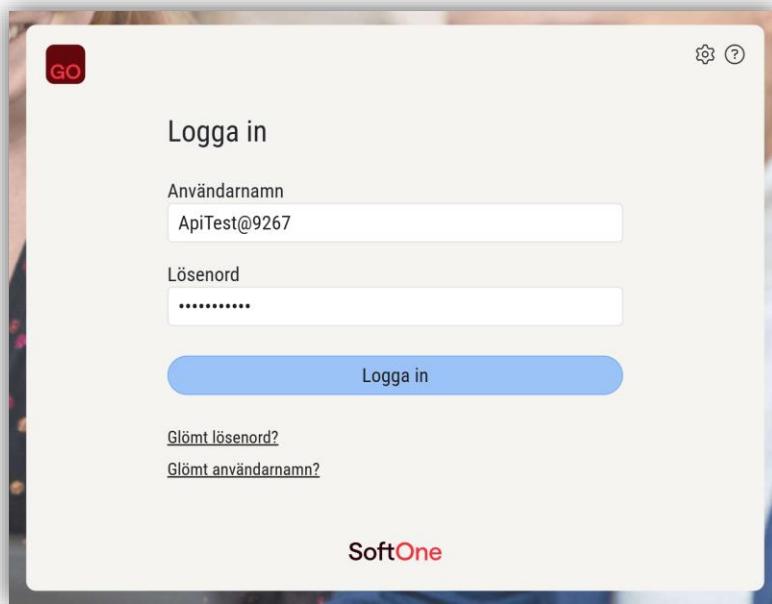
- **Reduce the size of the dataset:**
 - Fewer employees over a longer period
 - Or one day at a time for all employees
- **Split requests** into smaller chunks and combine them on your side (e.g. in Power BI)

This makes your integration more stable and responsive — especially when dealing with large reports.

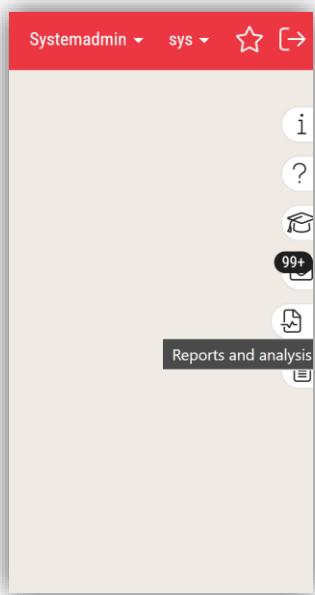
3.1 Application Reference – SoftOne GO

This section explains how the API data relates to the UI/logic in SoftOne GO. It helps new integrators connect what they see in the system with what they get via the API.

Perform Login using api account credentials



Click on the **Report and analysis** icon on right side of the screen.

From here you are able to view all analyze reports available. Click on one of the reports to open up next screen.
